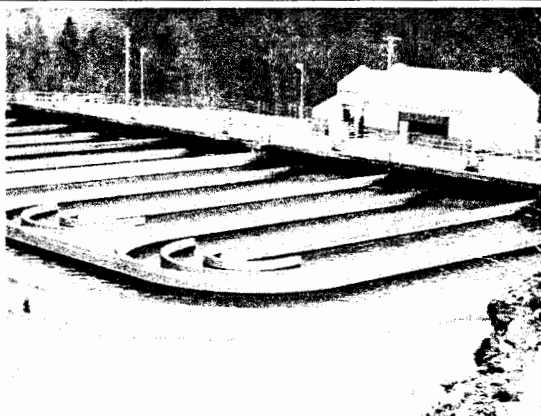


# THREAT TO LAKE OF THE OZARKS

## Quarry Blasting Threatens Lake Regional Wastewater Facility & the entire community Help Us Help You!



- Magruder Limestone of Troy, MO has requested a permit to operate a quarry adjacent to the Joint Wastewater Treatment Plant and Woodriver Road Community.
- The plant serves all the Osage Beach and Lake Ozark businesses, residences, schools, churches, nursing homes and the Lake Regional Hospital. There is no other option.
- If the plant has to be closed, the Lake's economy and environment are at risk. Quarry blasting and operations near the plant and the force mains present that threat.
- Missouri DNR strongly recommended that all concerned parties secure legal representation for the process to stop the permit, which included a seven day formal hearing.
- The Joint Sewer Board retained legal counsel to represent their concerns that blasting threatens the plant operations and the force mains.
- Due to the effects an environmental and economic disaster will have on the Lake of the Ozarks entire area, The Concerned Citizens of Miller and Camden Counties hired an attorney to represent the concerns of everyone whose health, safety and livelihood will be adversely affected.
